MRS. CO'C. MOMBERGER DIED HERE LAST SUNDAY

After an Illness Covering Period of More Than a Year, Wife of Prominent Farmer Passed Away.

Mrs. C. C. Momberger died at her home near this city Sunday after an illness of more than a year's duration. A complication of diseases caused her death.

Christina Lee Jacobs was born in St. Louis November 28, 1856. She moved with her parents to this section in 1885, and has since been a resident here. She was married to C. Momberger January 4, 1893, and to this union three children were born: Joseph, Harry and Elsie, who with her husband, survive her.

She united with the Pilgrim Presbyterian church when 18 years of age and moved her membership to the Wellsville Presbyterian church, to which institution she remained a member until her death. She was an ardent and enthusiastic church worker during the active part of her life.

The funeral was conducted from the home Monday morning by Rev. Jesse L. Coleman, after which the body was taken to St. Louis and interment made in a St. Louis cemetery.
